

## March Against Monsanto

2 Million people marched against the seed giant Monsanto on Saturday May 25, 2013 in a around the world protest.

52 countries in 436 cities joined forces to raise awareness of the negative affects of GMO (genetically modified organisms) to the earth and to our bodies.

Most recently, Monsanto acquired a law of protection in the United States government.

Monsanto has been responsible for the fact that 80% of all foods on our grocery store shelves contain GMO ingredients.
